

The Johnson and Johnson Consumer Care Center helped plant 3 acres of potatoes by hand at America's Grow-a-Row (AGAR) this past week. AGAR, located in Pittstown, donates free produce to those suffering from hunger. Almost 50 Johnson and Johnson volunteers spent four hours cutting, preparing and planting potato seeds that are expected to yield up to around 50,000 pounds of fresh potatoes later in the season, which will then be delivered to hunger relief agencies all across New Jersey.
